- 9:30am** **Depart Melbourne CBD for Yarra Valley**

- Kellybrook** An abundance of real style and personality. Kellybrook is a lovely oasis in the old Yarra Valley orchard belt. Founded in 1962 and making both still and sparkling wines from apples grown in the orchard. Today the vines vastly outnumber the apple trees with Kellybrook being granted the Yarra Valley's first vigneron's license, in 1970. It's one of the few small wineries in the Yarra Valley still owned by the original family. With its distinctive character and 'hands-on' approach, Kellybrook has much to offer the visitor.
- Yering Station** Yering Station is one of Australia's most spectacular winery set-ups. The enthusiastic and knowledgeable cellar door staff will share with you some of Yering Station's award winning benchmark classic Australian wines. After our tasting take your seats in the award winning restaurant for your delicious lunch.
- Domaine Chandon** French Champagne company Moët & Chandon's Australian production house, Domaine Chandon is the perfect way to enjoy your afternoon with a guided tour through the winery that shows how the wine is made. This is followed by a relaxing glass of Australia's best bubbly with tasty light nibbles and a view that will leave you in awe. Spectacular, to say the least.
- Yering Farm** The cellar door which is a converted old hay shed is situated at the top of the hill, overlooking stunning views, this charming rustic cellar door, oozing with character is a fantastic environment to enjoy superb wines made with traditional winemaking techniques. The cellar door proudly showcases antique cooper tools used by pioneer winemakers over a century ago.
